



GIANT BUBBLE RECIPE



This recipe makes 1 gallon of bubble solution. I like to mix it in a recycled plastic milk carton. Use a funnel to avoid a mess!

Ingredients

- 15 cups lukewarm water
- 1 tsp guar gum (found in baking aisle of grocery stores or you can order online)
- 2 tsp baking powder
- 2 tsp (approximately) rubbing alcohol
- 1/2 Cup plus 1 1/2 Tbsp Dish Soap - I like to use Dawn.

Directions

- Measure warm water into jug or mixing container
- Measure guar gum into a small dish. Add enough alcohol to make a slurry (thick mix that can pour). Stir until smooth.
- Add guar gum mixture to water in jug. If any guar gum is left in bowl, add a little of the water to stir and then add to the main jug. Put lid on jug and gently turn over several times to mix. Don't shake enough to create bubbles.
- Add detergent. Gently swirl to mix.
- Add baking powder. Mix one final time without creating bubbles.
- If possible let sit a few minutes but if you can't wait, get bubbling!
- Pour into a shallow container so there is about 1" of liquid. I like to use an oblong Tupperware type container.
- Bubble solution will keep for weeks in a closed container. I pour unused solution back into the jug, straining if necessary.

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
